Request for Proposals (**Deadline Extended**) CDBG Funds FY 2021-2022 and CDBG-CV Funds

U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development

The City of Huntington Park is expecting an annual allocation from the United States Housing and Urban Development Department (HUD), Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds for FY 2021-2022 as well as CDBG Cares Act funds (CDBG-CV). The City of Huntington Park is authorized by HUD to distribute CDBG funds to promote housing and community development for low- to -moderate income persons. In addition, the City of Huntington Park is authorized to distribute CDBG-CV (Coronavirus) funds to prevent and respond to the spread of COVID-19.

Here are a few of the program requirements:

- An organization must either provide a new service, not just a newly CDBG-funded service, or provide a quantifiable increase in the level of service provided in the previous 12 months.
- The organization must be located within Huntington Park *or* have been providing services for at least two years to low- and moderate- income persons in Huntington Park, either on the basis as a direct benefit to each income eligible person/household or assisting a limited clientele of whom 51 percent are income eligible or who are presumed eligible (e.g., seniors, homeless, disabled persons).
- Your organization must service individuals that meet the current HUD income limits.
- CDBG-CV programs must provide services that are directly related to the prevention and or response to the spread of COVID-19
